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STHAPATI (ARCHITECT)

Dr K.Dakshinamurthy Sthapati comes from a distinguished lineage of architects who have significantly shaped India's architectural landscape for centuries. With a PhD in architectural heritage studies, he skillfully blends modern techniques with traditional design principles outlined in ancient scriptures. His unwavering passion and deep commitment to the enduring beauty of architecture and sculptural heritage have earned him international acclaim.

Currently, he serves as an Expert Sthapati member on the high-level heritage committee for the Hindu Religious & Charitable Endowments Department of the Government of Tamil Nadu, focusing on the preservation and conservation of ancient temples. He is the Managing Trustee of the Vastu Vedic Trust, founded by his maternal uncle, Dr V. Ganapati Sthapati. Through this trust, he is working to carry out his uncle's registered will and vision of promoting architectural and sculptural values. Also, he is the founder and proprietor of Vedic Architects and Sculptors, through which he designs and oversees the temple projects. His administrative office is located in Chennai, India.



LEGACY - VISION

He comes from the renowned Mayaas lineage of Indian architects, celebrated in history for creating magnificent temples, sculptures, and all other structures that have stood the test of time for many thousands of years. His father, the esteemed Silpakalanidi Sri. SK. Achary designed the iconic Vivekananda Rock Memorial in Kanyakumari. Dr V. Ganapati Sthapati, his maternal uncle and a Padma Bhushan awardee, sculpted the magnificent 133-foot Valluvar stone statue in Kanyakumari. K. Dakshinamoorthy studied the art from his uncle, Dr V. Ganapati Sthapati. As a Managing Trustee of his uncle's trust, he is dedicated to introducing advanced research studies on architectural heritage in collaboration with the renowned Vinayaka Mission. His vision includes establishing an architectural museum and completing the memorial for Mayan, the founder of architectural science.

PROJECTS - MENTIONING FEW IMPORTANT

He masterfully designs buildings and sculptures that exude powerful emotion and vibrant energy. Each creation reflects his distinctive signature style, achieving an impeccable harmony of scale, geometry, and aesthetics that captivates and inspires. He has successfully created and implemented a variety of temple projects both in India and abroad. His commitment to ancient design principles ensures that each project is tailored to its unique location while skillfully integrating traditional and modern materials, such as GFRC. Sthapati has designed temples across India and countries such as the USA, Canada, the UK, Sri Lanka, Singapore, Malaysia, Australia, and New Zealand.

Sri Thirumurugan temple in Montreal, Canada, has a large temple complex with the main shrine, all subshrines, and ornamentally sculpted pillars depicting the Arupadai Veedu deities. The temple was consecrated in 2006. Recently, Rajagopuram was constructed in Granite stone, and carved stones were shipped from India.

Sri Shivamurugan Temple in Concord, California, consecrated in 2025, reflects the growth of Hindu culture in the United States. From its modest beginnings to its current expansive complex, the temple embodies the adaptation and preservation of cultural heritage through a blend of traditional Hindu elements and modern amenities. The temple features a Rajagopuram and main Garbhagraham constructed from glass-reinforced concrete, adorned with traditional multicoloured finishes (Pancha Varnam). The interior sanctums are made of granite, while the external walls and other ornamental details are crafted from concrete. Designed by experts to withstand seismic activity, this temple ensures both durability and safety.

Sri Venkateswara Temple in the United Kingdom, located in Tividale, West Midlands, spans over 10 acres. Constructed primarily from granite, the temple features a large sanctum sanctorum and a tall Rajagopuram. In addition to the main temple, there are dedicated temples for Murugan and Ganesh at the front, along with several sub-temples. The complex also includes a community hall and a dining hall, making it the largest temple in Europe. This impressive structure was commenced 25 years ago.

Sri Gnana Bhairava Temple, located in Araly, Sri Lanka, was constructed in 2025, in the 8th-century style in accordance with the Pallava school of architecture. The Pallava style is distinguished by its unique profiles, geometric forms, and proportions, representing a meticulous adaptation of timber-and-brick architectural principles into enduring stone structures. This project presents a significant opportunity for the Sthapati to revitalise the Pallava architectural tradition after a lapse of 1,200 years. It has facilitated a deeper understanding of the Pallava style, enabling the Sthapati to articulate its intricate nuances in contemporary times.

Sri Gokarnanatheswara Temple in Mangalore was designed, and work began by Sthapati at the age of 28 in 1987. This project earned him praise from former Prime Minister of India, Rajiv Gandhi, and former President R. Venkatraman during their visits to this temple. Completed in just 13 months, the temple involved the work of hundreds of craftsmen. The complex features a magnificent middle Chola-style Rajagopuram, an elegant temple layout, an auditorium, and separate temples dedicated to Sri Saibaba and Sri Hanuman, drawing many visitors.

Sri Someswar Temple, located in Nangavalli near Salem, is a remarkable example of the best architectural design. This expansive temple complex features numerous subsidiary shrines centred around the principal deity, Sri Someshwara. The temple is constructed in the Chola style of architecture, which contributes significantly to its aesthetic appeal and structural elegance.
